

## Checklist: Planning KNX successfully

For homeowners planning to implement their smart home with KNX

| I. Fundamental decisions  |
|---|
| $\square$ I have considered which functions I want to automate (e.g. lighting, heating, blinds).  |
| $\square$ I know whether I want to network just a few rooms or the entire house.  |
| $\square$ I am integrating KNX right from the start – either during new construction or renovation.   |
| $\square$ I have decided whether to use a wired solution or wireless components (KNX RF).   |
| 2. Planning preparation   |
| $\square$ I have discussed my smart home requirements with my architect or house planner.   |
| $\square$ I already have an electrical plan – or I'm integrating KNX from the outset.   |
| ☐ I have outlined initial scenarios or use cases (e.g. "away mode", "evening lighting", "morning wake-up").                                     |
| 3. Implementation & technology  |
| $\square$ I have hired an electrician or KNX system integrator with experience.   |
| $\square$ I have a rough budget in mind for the smart home features.  |
| $\square$ I have discussed with the integrator where switches, sensors and control units will be installed.                                     |
| $\square$ I am taking future expandability into account (e.g. garage, garden, upper floor).   |
| 1. Future-proofing & documentation  |
| $\square$ I have planned empty conduits or spare cables for future extensions.  |
| $\square$ I know whether I want to control my system via smartphone or voice command in future.   |
| ☐ I have a preference for certain devices or manufacturers.   |
| $\square$ I have agreed with the integrator who will maintain or update the system in the future.   |
| ☐ I will request full system documentation and the project configuration file (ETS file) upon handover, so the future adjustments are possible. |

**Tip:** Keep all project documents in a safe place – they will be useful for future changes or if you change integrators.
